You may only use www.wordreference.com to find words. You can always have more than 5 items in each section of your menu!

Your grade will be based on the following:

- Format/Required Items (25 points - 1 point per item)
- Spelling (10 points)
- Effort (Is it colorful? Is it easy to read? Did you put time into it?) (5 points)
